The successful candidate for this position must possess the following qualifications:

- Degree or diploma in related field Activation, Gerontology or Recreation.
- Minimum of 2 years experience working in an Adult Day Program setting
- Experience working with vulnerable or high-risk populations, including palliative, seniors and adults with disabilities and cognitive impairments.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills; excellent organizational and interpersonal skills
- Strong working knowledge of client documentation systems
- Current First Aid & C.P.R. certification required
- Previous experience working in a healthcare setting
- Possess creativity, empathy, enthusiasm, and compassion
- Successful completion of *Vulnerable Sector Screening* within one month of employment

The successful candidate(s) for this position must be able to:

- Develop programs based on Individual Program Plans regarding the needs and desires of the program participants including culturally appropriate programs
- Assist clients in activities of daily living such as medication reminder, toileting etc.
- Prepare, set-up and clean-up the program, equipment and supplies
- Facilitate recreation, social and exercise programs and supports other staff, students and volunteers who assist with these programs
- Fulfil Health and Safety documentation and reporting responsibilities. Maintains knowledge, observes, and practices appropriate procedures in regards to Fire, Safety, Quality and environmental standards.
- Able to function responsibly and independently in a stressful environment while maintaining a professional demeanor
- Promote programs and special events by developing and disseminating all program brochures, newsletters etc.
- Adhere to the Policies and Procedures as outlined in the Personnel Manual.
